Working with Local Area Coordinators

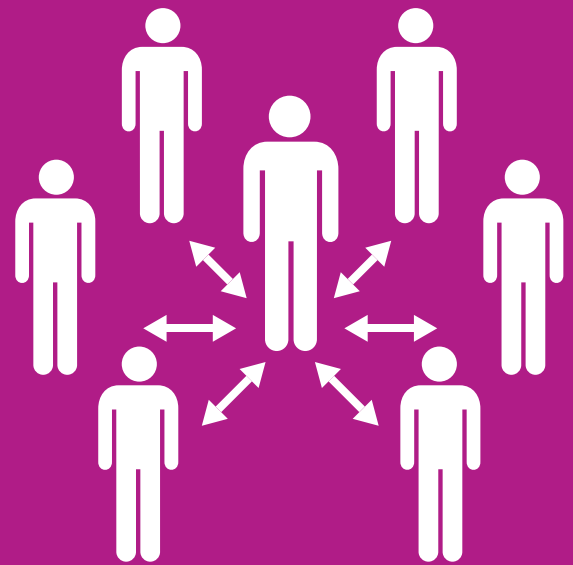
Let's discuss the changes, opportunities and challenges that the introduction of the large-scale LAC system will bring for community information, capacity building and advocacy organisations.
