Planning and standing strong

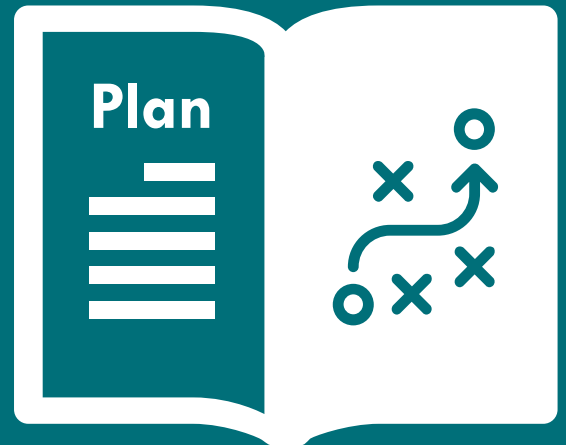
The NDIS Planning process can seem complicated. This session breaks down the steps so you can help Participants get ready.
